

**PUBLIC NOTICE dated March 17, 2004**

Re: On-Line Access to Court Documents  
People of the State of California vs. Marcus Wesson

Pursuant to [Rule of Court 2073.5\(d\) \[Remote electronic access allowed in individual criminal cases\]](#) the Fresno County Superior Court is giving notice of its intention to post public documents filed in the case of *People v. Marcus Wesson*.

You are hereby notified that it is the Court's intent to issue an order on Monday, March 22, 2004 permitting remote electronic access to all court records in the *Wesson* case excepting that confidential records will not be posted, nor records that have not been redacted as described in Rule 2073.5(c).

Specifically, the following information shall be redacted from records before remote access is allowed: driver license numbers; dates of birth; social security numbers; Criminal Identification and Information and National Crime Information numbers; addresses, and phone numbers of parties, victims, witnesses, and court personnel; medical and psychiatric information; financial information; account numbers; and other personal identifying information.

Pursuant to Rule 2073.5(c), the Court will order that any party who files a document containing such information shall provide the court with both an original unredacted version of the document for filing in the court file and a redacted version of the document for remote electronic access.

The Court will further order that no juror names or other juror identifying information may be provided by electronic access.
